# **THE FOREIGN BIRD FEDERATION BREEDING REGISTER**

The **FOREIGN BIRD FEDERATION (FBF) REGISTER OF BIRDS BRED IN THE UK UNDER CONTROLLED CONDITIONS FOR THE YEARS 2005-2008** lists, from information volunteered by individual bird owners, avicultural organisations and public collections alike, close to 50,000 breedings of almost 950 foreign species in recent years.

The FBF Breeding Register (ISSN 1352 - 838X) dates from 1984. It is lodged with the British Library and provides the public domain with a numerical account of some of the annually produced thousands of foreign birds bred by UK bird owners whose delight in bird breeding stems from a range extending from individual hobby interest through to large-scale public collections.

The voluntary nature of data submission can lead to marked fluctuations in year-on-year records. That being said, year-on-year figures are potential indicators of the foreign bird species available (sustainable?) from stocks of UK-bred birds. Each issue of the Breeding Register covers a four-year retro-period, which allows for some later received data to be included into the three earliest years of a particular edition.

The common names of species are taken from sometimes several such names used in field guides and UK foreign bird owning parlance, whilst the scientific nomenclature is drawn from current texts. The order of species is based on *THE HOWARD AND MOORE COMPLETE CHECKLIST OF THE BIRDS OF THE WORLD*, third edition, Christopher Helm, London, 2003.

Currently, and operating within the nature of the publication, named individual contributors receive a complimentary copy of the Breeding Register.

A total of 946 species are recorded for the years 2001-2008 inclusive and more will have been bred prior to 2001. In 2008 there were raised 86 species unrecorded during 2001-2007. Some of these species will have been bred in earlier times; whilst others - being First Recorded UK Breedings - will stand as milestones of achievement in the history of UK aviculture.
